EMERGENCY Response

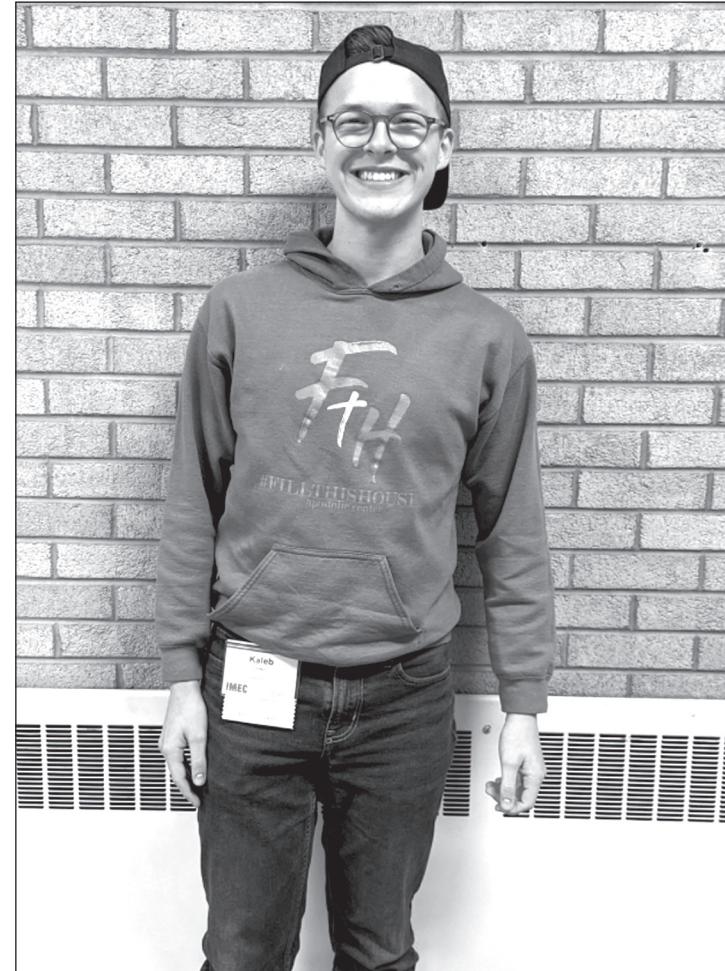
Sunday, Jan. 29
