free-standing accredited sport university in the United States.

Modzelewski has also donated his drawings to libraries, hospitals and schools.

While his main work has been focused on drawings, he's done a little bit of everything. He painted a 300-foot-long mural leading to Shelbyville which took him two and a half years. He also painted metal figures that are bolted into walls in Shelbyville. He painted a paperboy, and his wife watering flowers in the Shelbyville Sunken Garden.

Modzelewski graduated from the Art Institute of Chicago. Originally he was planning to work in the advertising field, creating artwork for advertisements. His plans changed when his friend in college asked him to be a substitute teacher for a Saturday morning class for high school kids. He fell in love with teaching and went back to school for two years to get a degree in education.

"I loved working with students- high school and college students were phenomenal, creative, energetic, loving kids. The more different they were, the more I wanted to work with them," said Modzelewski.

He taught high school art at Downers Grove for 30 years. He also taught night classes at nearby Du Page University in Glen Ellyn during that time. Modzelewski spent another five years teaching art at Grayslake before taking an early retirement. However, that didn't stop him from doing some more work with students. He was in charge of student teachers at Northern Illinois University for a year.

Modzelewski moved to Shelbyville in 2002 and focused his time on being a practicing artist. He displayed art in the Flourishes Gallery in Shelbyville. He was also a member of Gallery 510 in Decatur and displayed his art there for almost 20 years.

"It's an extremely beautiful, nice gallery," said Modzelewski. "I was fortunate to have that kind of support system."

Since 2021 he's lived in Champaign to be closer to his family. His wife's niece steered Modzelewski to The Vault.

"It's exciting for me, a new venue," said Modzelewski. "You're never done and never fully satisfied and you just keep doing it. Its all just a process."
