Every coach I have had along the way because me and my coaches had a closer bond than my school teachers.

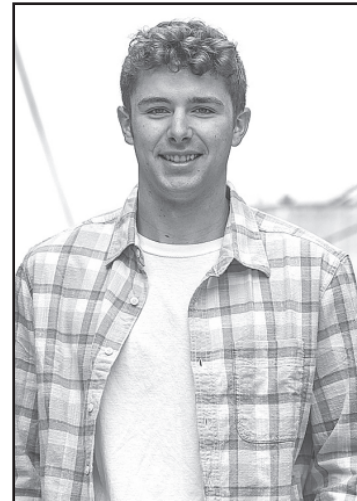
