The Most influential person throughout high school is my mom. The past 4 years she has helped me through so much. She is my hero.

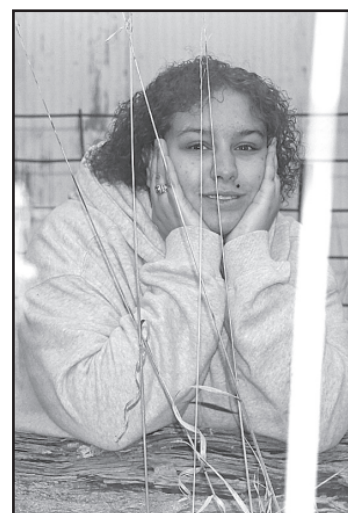

If you could, what advice would you give yourself on your first day at TCHS?

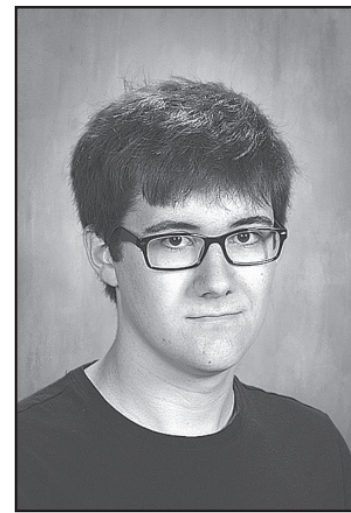
Being realistic can save you from pain and disappointment.
