period study hall. They have the option to stay, but if they choose to leave, they must sign out. This will act as an incentive for students to keep their grades up, as well as allow students needing extra help to have more teacher attention.

For the new cell phone policy, students must keep their devices off and in their lockers. The only exception is high school students, who may have their devices at their lunch hour. Students will also have the option to rent a lock for their locker. If a student has had multiple phone violations, they may be asked to leave their phone in the principal's office at the beginning of the school day and will pick it up at the end of the school day.

Students with vehicles will now have a deadline for vehicle registration. This comes in response to past issues with unregistered student vehicles.

Superintendent Munson gave updates on the solar project financing. The district was approved for a loan through Capital One public funds. However, before final approval through Capital One, the district hopes to explore a more local option for financing. Regardless, the district has a loan option for the new solar project.

Dr. Munson also updated the Board on the status of summer projects. The exterior door project has been delayed with an anticipated start date being the end of July. Exterior window projects are on track with start date being July 10.

The baseball field netting and fencing project should begin soon with shop drawings coming this week.

Many concerned parents called about the updates to the baseball field instead of the softball field. Munson clarified that the baseball field was a more immediate safety concern with the fly balls. Softball also has a much tighter timeline. The Board projects softball updates for next June. Softball will be getting field updates this summer.

For elementary updates, Bobby Beck notes that summer tutoring is underway. This program was made possible through training at Illinois State University and a tutoring initiative grant through the state of Illinois.

For junior high and high school updates, Sara Jones thanked the Board for their participation in eighth grade and high school promotion. Jones also congratulated members of track, baseball, and softball on their recent achievements.

The Board will reconvene on July 17, 2023 at 6 pm.
