The cameras can send information directly to officers in the field if they scan a license plate or vehicle associated with a crime.

Chaplin said The cameras do not capture the speed of a vehicle, nor any information about the registration. He also said the cameras are unable to scan facial features. Chaplin compared the cameras to an officer only running license plates, and nothing else. Officers on duty still have to respond to any alerts brought by the cameras.

"We still have to get probable cause. It helps, but it's not a catch-all," said Chaplin.

The solar-powered cameras will be placed in high-traffic areas along Route 36 to get

the most use and data out of them. The county leased them for two years. The cameras cost \$3,000 per year, totaling to \$12,000. The installation costs \$4,500. Chaplin said the cameras also receive free upgrades if they become outdated during the lease.

Chaplin said that the cameras connect to a network of other cameras in surrounding counties, such as Edgar or Champaign County. The cameras can alert police in Douglas County if it picks up a vehicle traveling in that direction.

"Douglas County is about 416 square miles. It's a challenge for us to be in the right place at the right time. This is something that will help us indicate where we have areas of need and guide us in that direction," said Chaplin.

Chaplin said the cameras

will not face any houses. They only face the road, where there is no expectation of privacy. According to Flock Safety, the data only stays for 30 days. After which it is purged from the system automatically. Chaplin said he is more comfortable with these cameras than with automated speed cameras, which can send a ticket directly to a driver who was photographed speeding.

The Illinois General Assembly passed a bill that regulates ALPRs.

The bill protects the data of people traveling from other states to Illinois seeking sexual health care, such as abortions. The bill was sent to Governor JB Pritzker to be signed.

The bill states that the ALPR user can't sell, share or trade data, unless to other police departments as part of

an investigation into a state or federal crime.

Depending on the success of the cameras, Chaplin will look into "sponsored cameras." These cameras would be sponsored by private businesses or organizations that would like to have a camera in the vicinity.

In other news:

The Board approved funds for bridge repair support for Villa Grove. The board is giving Villa Grove \$85,348 for the bridge located over the Embarrass River on Front Street. Failing bridge joints will be replaced on the structure. The total project is estimated to cost \$170,696.

The Board approved the process for the opioid settlement fund. Clerk and Recorder Judi Pollock said that a committee comprised of representa-

tives from the Douglas County Health Department, RISE Behavioral Health and Wellness, Sheriff's Department, National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), resident Jim Young and a board member will study ways to spend money collected from the settlement.

Douglas County will receive \$36,000 from the opioid settlement, which involved pharmaceutical distributing com-

panies Cardinal, McKesson and AmerisourceBergen and manufacturer Johnson and Johnson.

The Board will re-evaluate cleaning services in the Sheriff's Office, Douglas County Annex and Douglas County Courthouse. County Board Chairman Tom Hettinger will evaluate the cleaning services to see if there is need for more or less services.

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
