 20A few evening came, Jesus was reclining at the table with the Twelve. 21 And while they were eating, he said, "Truly I tell you, one of you will betray me." 22 They were very sad and began to say to him one after the other, "Handy you don't mean me, Lord?" 23 Jesus replied, "The one who has dipped his hand into the bowl with me will betray me. 24 The Son of Man will go just as it is written about him. But now to that man who betrays the Son of Man, it would be better for him if he had not been born." 25 Then Judas, the one who would betray him, said, "Handy you don't mean me, Rabbi?" Jesus answered, "The one said it!" 26A while they were eating, Jesus took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it and gave it to his disciples, saying, "Take and eat this is my body." 27 Then he took a cup, and when he had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. 28 This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins. 29 I will not drink from this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom." 30After they had sung a hymn, they went out to the Mount of Olives. - *Matthew 26: 28-30*

Jesus Arrested
 47While he was still speaking, Judas, one of the Twelve, arrived. With him was a large crowd armed with swords and clubs, sent from the chief priests and the elders of the people. 48Now the betrayer had arranged a signal with them: "The one I kiss is the man arrest him," offering it over to Jesus. Judas said, "Greetings, Rabbi!" and kissed him. 28Jesus replied, "Do what you came here to do." Then the man stepped forward, seized Jesus and arrested him. 30With that, one of Jesus' companions reached for his sword, drew it out and struck the servant of the high priest, cutting off his ear. 32 "Put your sword back to its place," Jesus said to him. "For all who draw the sword will die by the sword. 33Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels? But how then would the Scriptures be fulfilled that say it must happen to this way?" - *Matthew 26: 47-54*
