

# Lady Dragons lose three last week

Lady Dragons Lose Three Last Week  
After picking up their biggest win of the young season by beating Bethlehem for the 5th Region All A championship, the Lady Dragons struggled last week, losing all three of their games.  
More importantly, two of the three losses were to district rivals, LaRue County and Hart County. This is the first time since 2008 that Green County has lost to both of those teams in the same season. The Lady Dragons' season record is now 4-5.

**Taylor County 11 Green County 5**  
Green County took an early lead in the game by scoring in the top of the first inning. Taylor County retaliated with a big inning of their own, scoring four runs.  
The Lady Dragons tied it up in the third

inning but allowed Taylor to have two more big innings. The Lady Cards scored three in the bottom of the fourth and added four more in the bottom of the sixth inning.
