Green County Ky. ASAP hosted ninth grade students from Green County High School for Truth and Consequences last week.

The scenario based role-play activity held each year at the Green County Judicial Center is designed as a way to educate students about the physical, legal, financial and emotional consequences related to substance and alco-

hol abuse. It is designed to empower students to make informed and good choices when faced with real life situations.

Community volunteers and older students from the Green County Youth Coalition Group volunteered to serve as "parents" accompanying students as they visited various agencies such as law enforcement, school officials, judge, county attorney, victim

advocate, jailer, hospital, health department, counseling and recovery, court designated worker, the coroner, funeral home, and minister.

Adanta Regional Prevention, The Healing Place and Kentucky State Police also participated with presentations on vaping, the dangers of distracted driving, and addiction recovery.
