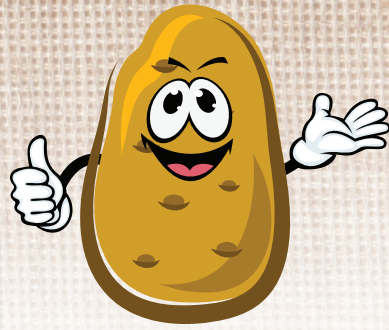
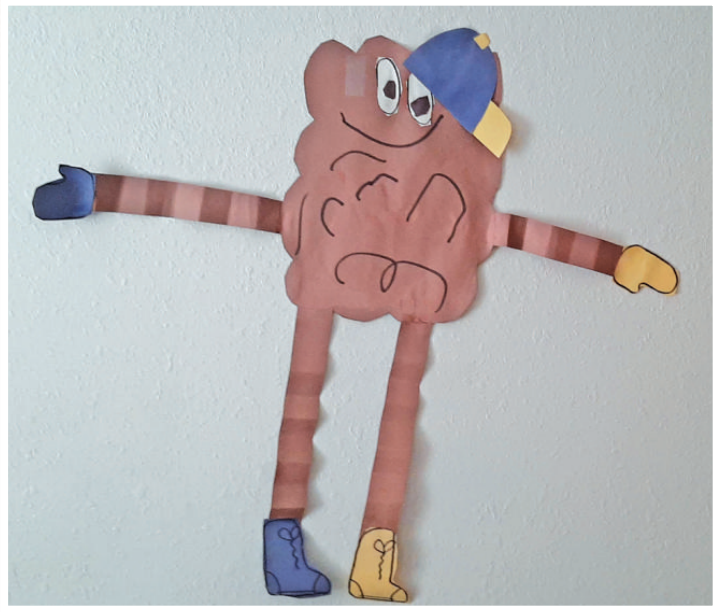


Potato People Have Begun Sprouting Up
