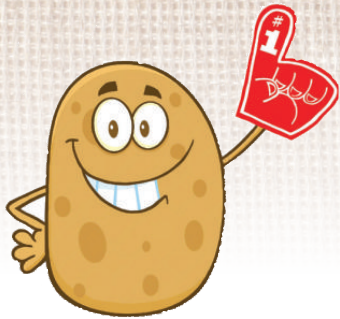


Having Fun, Fun, Fun In The Barrel Train

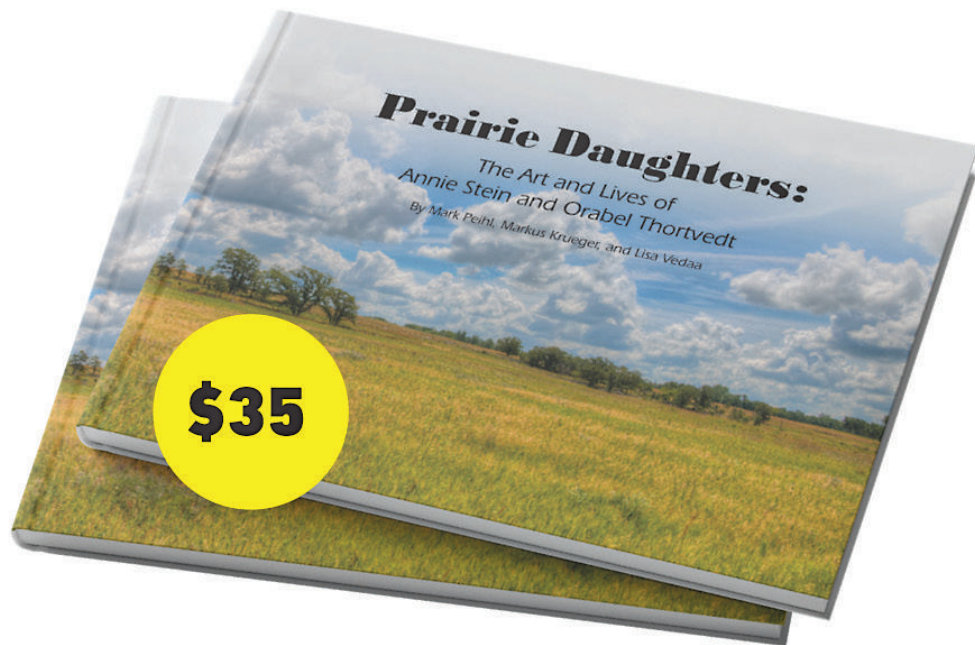
