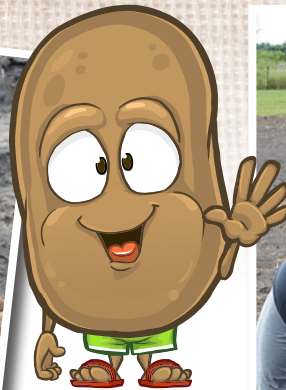


# Outstanding Kids In Their Potato Field
