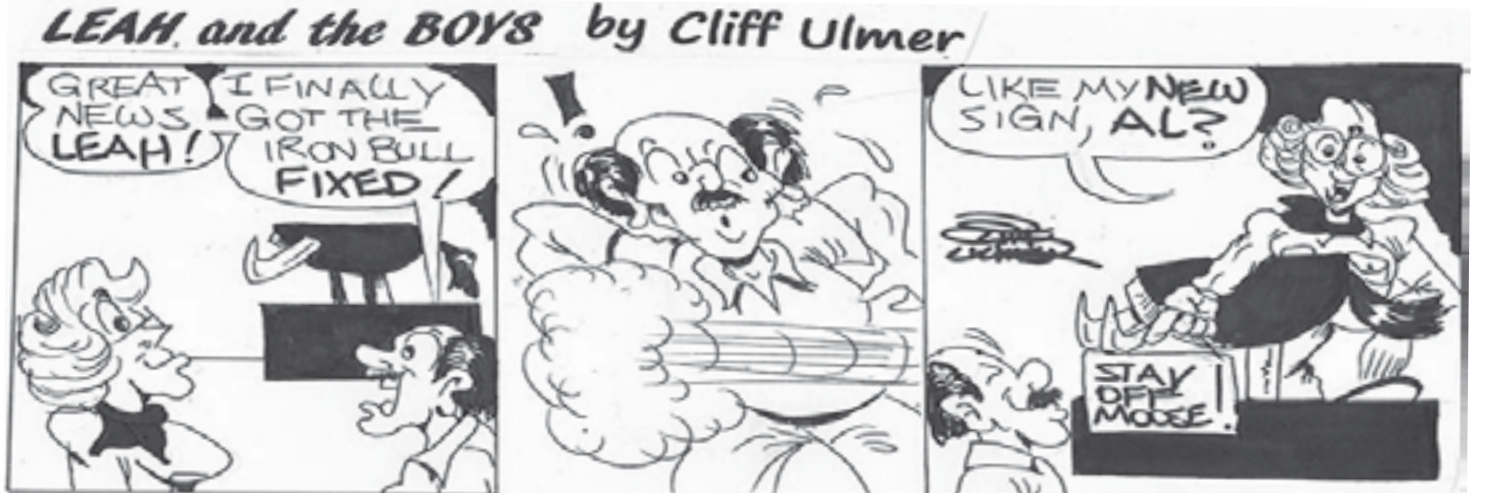


GRINS & GIGGLES
