

ACSO Arrests Four Atkinson County Probation Violators

ATKINSON COUNTY, Georgia – The Atkinson County Sheriff’s Office (ACSO) has announced the arrest of four people on felony probation violation charges on Friday, February 16th. The four people failed to check-in at an Atkinson County residence. On Friday, February 2nd, ACSO Deputies conducted the probation check-in at a Pearson home of probationer Jonathan White in Pearson. The home is situated on Highway 84.

The failure of the four probationers to check-in prompted the ACSO deputies to seek and arrest the four convicted felons on several felony charges.

Law enforcement indicates that the four were listed and charged as follows:

- Jonathan White (40) of Pearson:
 - Possession of drug-related objects
 - Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon
 - Possession of methamphetamine
- Michael Bennett (52) of Pearson:
 - Possession of drug-related objects
 - Possession of methamphetamine



- Tiffany Altman (31) of Nicholls
 - Possession of drug-related objects
- Jeremy Godwin (35) of Pearson
 - Possession of drug-related objects

- Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon
- Possession of methamphetamine
- Obstruction
