

LCSO Indicates Anderson, Missing Person, has been Found

LOWNDES COUNTY, Georgia - The Lowndes County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) issued a public request for help in locating Gregory Antonio Anderson (35) on Wednesday, February 14th. LCSO has been found. The LCSO is extending its thanks for help in their search for the missing man.

Anderson has been described as a 6'01" man weighing 190 lbs. According to LCSO, Anderson was last seen by his family when he was dropped off near the 600 block of Lee Street on Tuesday, January 30th.

LCSO Officials say the last contact with Anderson was in the 1500 block of Baytree Road near Remerton. He was last seen wearing a red hoodie and blue jeans. During LCSO's search for the man, Anderson was admitted to GCIC/NCIC.

GCIC and NCIC are the two electronic clearinghouses for crime data. GCIC is the acronym for the Georgia Crime Information Center and NCIC stands for the National Crime Information Center. No further information about Anderson or the LCSO's successful location of Anderson are available at this time.

Georgians Arrested or Prosecuted for Both Firearms and Drug Distribution

SOUTH GEORGIA – The Southern District of Georgia's U.S. Attorney's Office has announced that nine (9) South Georgians are facing charges. The charges were made on Wednesday, February 14th and include both Drug distribution and Possession of illegal firearms.

The U.S. Attorney's Office has listed the following February indictments:

- Deveon Daniels (25) of Grovetown
Illegal Possession of a machine gun
Possession of a Firearm by a convicted felon
- Matthew Lacey (26) of Savannah
Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon
Previous November 2023 Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon charges
- Justin Anthony Brown (32) of Augusta
Possession of a Firearm by a convicted felon

- Jacerio Maurice Famble (35) of Savannah
Conspiracy to possess with Intent to Distribute Psilocybin and Marijuana
Possession with Intent to Distribute Psilocybin and Marijuana
Possession of a firearm in furtherance of a drug trafficking crime
Possession of a Firearm by a convicted felon
- Aaron Jamonta Bennett (32) of Savannah
Conspiracy to possess with Intent to Distribute Psilocybin and Marijuana
Possession with Intent to Distribute Psilocybin and Marijuana

In the same announcement, the Southern District of Georgia's U.S. Attorney's Office reports that four (4) more people were recently adjudicated on firearm charges. All pleaded guilty and were sentenced as follows:

- Jonathan Duncan (38) of Savannah was sentenced to 64 months for Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon
- Keith Ponsell (34) of Jesup was sentenced to 24 months in prison for Possession of an unregistered firearm.
- William Zaccaeus Hightower (34) of Blackshear is awaiting sentencing for a guilty plea to Possession with intent to distribute cocaine and marijuana, and Possession of a machinegun .
- Christopher David Baskett (46) of Augusta is awaiting sentencing after pleading guilty to Possession of a firearm by a convicted felon.

The Southern District of Georgia U.S. Attorney's Office is the agency prosecuting these individuals on behalf of the United States.
