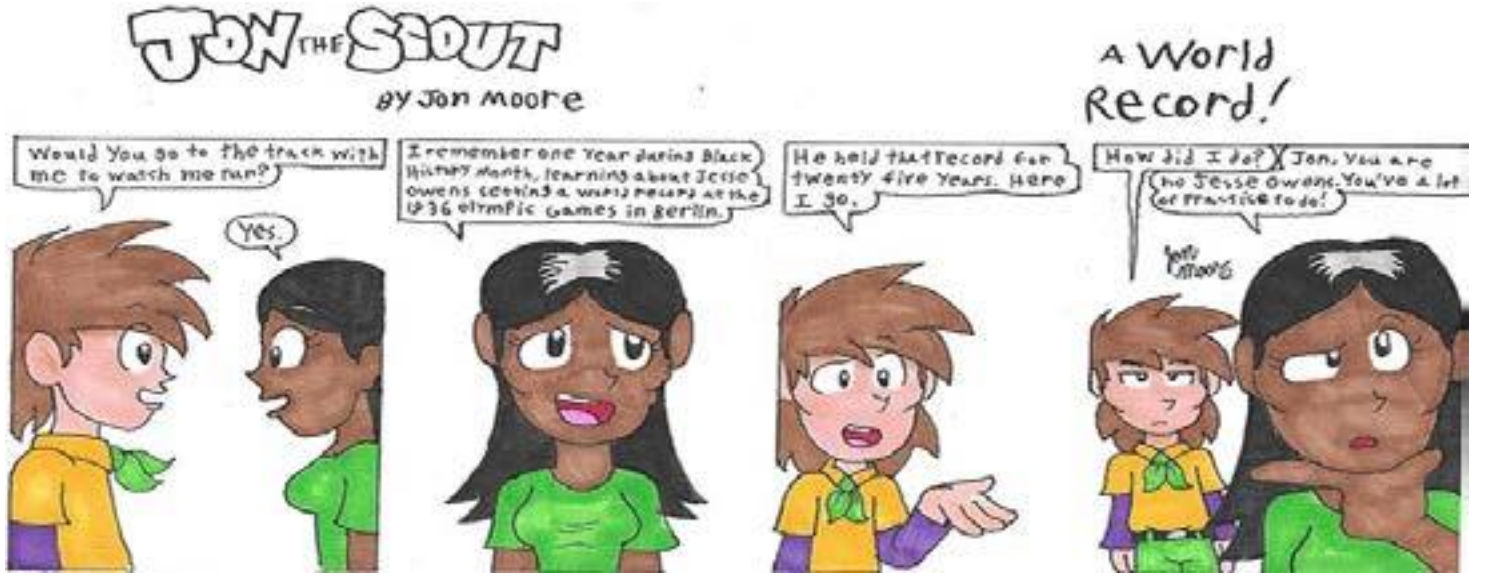


GRINS & GIGGLES

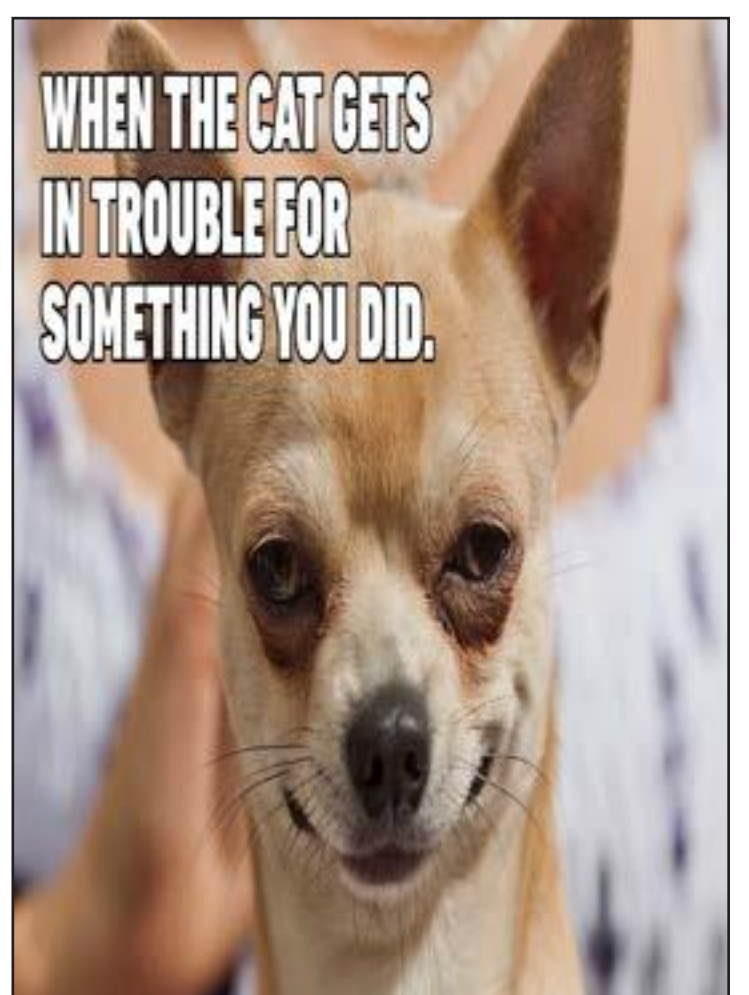
