**02/29-** Call for mutual aid to Clinch

County to help with a large fire at a mulch mill.

**02/29-** Call to a control burn on Hwy 125. Arrived to find that a debris fire had sparked the surrounding area and was spreading. Firemen had the fire under control within minutes.

**03/01-** Call to a gas leak on Hwy 125. Arrived to find that a boring crew had struck an underground gas line. The leak posed no threat to the surrounding area and fire units stood by for the gas company to arrive.

**03/02-** Call to an electrical fire on Street D. Arrived to find a problem with the A/C unit and shut of the power to the unit.

**03/03-** Call to a structure fire on Good Hope Road. Arrived to find smoke coming from a single wide mobile home. Firemen found a fire on the rear side of the trailer and extinguished it.
