

## Keeping Georgians Informed – Senator Reverend Ralph Warnock

Senator Warnock (D-GA), a member of the Senate Commerce committee which oversees national transportation and aviation policy has announced \$675,000 in Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funding to replace Cobb County International Airport's traffic control tower equipment. This funding helps ensure the safety of passengers and airport employees and improves the airport's efficiency.

"The Bipartisan Infrastructure Law is making Georgians safer every day," said Senator Reverend Warnock. "This funding will replace outdated air traffic control equipment, keeping our skies safe and our communities better connected. I'm proud to secure this funding with Senator Ossoff and I look forward to delivering more federal funding to the Peach State."

Warnock (D-GA) urged the Biden Administration to establish a bold, public framework for the U.S. to recognize a non-militarized Palestinian state. In a letter to the President, which was led by Senator Carper and co-signed by 17 of his Senate colleagues, Senator Warnock and his fellow lawmakers reiterated that the U.S. must continue to take concrete action toward a two-state solution, in line with established U.S. foreign policy.

"Given the severity of the current crisis, this moment requires determined U.S. leadership that must move beyond facilitation. As such, we request the Biden Administration promptly establish a bold, public framework outlining the steps necessary for the U.S. to recognize a non-militarized Palestinian state, which includes the West Bank and Gaza, to be governed by a revitalized and reformed Palestinian Authority," the Senators wrote.

On Tuesday, March 26, members of Senator Reverend Raphael Warnock's (D-GA) constituent services team will be in Blakely, Georgia for the latest Community Resource Connection Day (CRCD). CRCD is designed to address resource disparities and enhance community well-being in rural Georgia, with a focus on the South Georgia region. In collaboration with local officials and community partners, members of the Senator's staff will be ready to assist residents with federal agency inquiries and help cut through red tape to get answers on their issues regarding Medicare and Medicaid, Social Security, veterans and service members benefits, taxes, passports, visas, and more. The event will take place Tuesday, March 26 from 10:00am to 2:00pm at the Blakely Senior Center in Blakely, Georgia.

The event aims to bridge the gap between federal resources and communities across the state, as well as foster a sense of unity by providing a platform for residents to connect, share experiences, and support each other. Senator Warnock's team will gather insights on community needs and concerns to inform policy decisions and advocate for positive change, all while educating residents on navigating government systems and accessing resources independently. The flagship event offers a one-day opportunity for residents to access resources, and attend educational workshops and presentations. For planning purposes, this event is closed press.
