

## Morgan to replace Dickerson

(Continued from Page 1) told Dickerson. "Your leadership will continue to impact our football program for a long time."

Dickerson said when he came back to lead the team in 2024, it was meant to be on the interim basis, and he

is now ready to go back into retirement.

"I've been very fortunate to be the head football coach at Clinch County High for two different stints, and it's been an honor," Dickerson said. "It's given more back to me than I ever gave. I had a

lot of fun with the kids and coaches the last two seasons, but it was time to hand it back over to someone else."

Morgan becomes the fifth straight CCHS grad to lead the Panther football program, following Donald Tison (1974-1993), Cecil Bar-

ber (1994-2003), Dickerson (2004-2018 and 2024-2025), and Don Tison (2019-2023).

Morgan said he has met with the players, and is talking this week to football staff members about their roles for the upcoming season.

issue of solar farms. Moylan said the county doesn't currently have an ordinance addressing solar farms, and the county wants to "avoid thorny situations other counties have run into" concerning the matter.

Commissioner Tanya

O'Berry added that the county also needs to address data centers via ordinance. Commissioners indicated they would look into ordinances to address both issues.

• Approved a proposal from Beaver Reapers to clean debris from canals in the county.

Ricky Wade of Beaver Reapers presented a pro-

posal to clean 1.5 miles of canals in the county to improve drainage issues and alleviate flooding concerns, costing \$57,500. Wade said the canals were in the Gilligan Circle and Reddick

Street area of Homerville. A motion to approve the proposal was approved.

Moylan said the county will pay for the project with T-SPLOST funds.

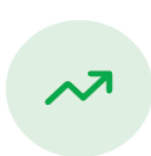
