

Charlton County Historical Society offering 'Stump Stories' dinner theater

The Charlton County Historical Society and Charlton County High School Theater Company invite the community to "Stump Stories", an original dinner theater production celebrating America's 250th anniversary and Charlton County's vibrant history.

Written by Carolyn DeLoach and directed by Natalie Newvine and Katy Ruth Huling, the show features monologues from six real historical figures, each sharing their story from a single stump on

the historic Traders Hill Pavilion stage—site of an 18th-century trading post and the original county seat along the St. Marys River.

The characters include Ya'Holo (Lower Creek warrior, 1793), Captain William Cone (frontier militiaman, 1812), Samuel Hannans (free man voting for the first time, 1866), William T. Chesser (swamp settler, 1870s), John Allen "Blackjack" Johnson (Traders Hill merchant, 1890s), and Lydia Smith Stone ("Queen of the Okefenokee," early 1900s). A

modern 10-year-old girl, Katie, ties the past to the present.

Enjoy a catered dinner by Cane Pole Café at 7:00 p.m., followed by the 45–60-minute performance at 8:15 p.m. on Friday, April 24, and Saturday, April 25, 2026, at Traders Hill Pavilion in Folkston.
