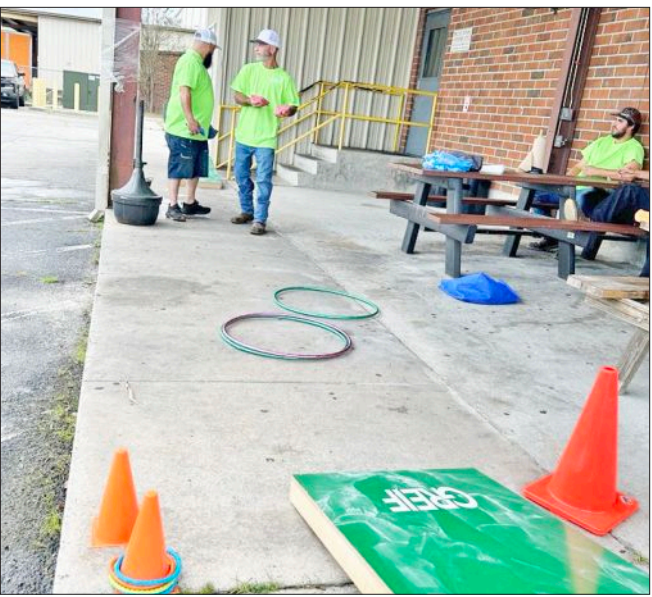
team members received Safety Week t-shirts in pink and neon green featuring the Greif logo.
