Dr. James also spoke about the attendance report for this year for faculty with an emphasis of 61 faculty members missing 10.5 to 15 days throughout the school year. Board Chairman Stanley Thrift mentioned raising the amount of money the school awarded to any faculty member who has perfect attendance. No action was taken on the matter.
