the Small Business Tax Cuts Act (H.5006), delivering real relief to the small businesses that are the backbone of our communities. More than 99% of South Carolina businesses are small businesses, from the local diner to the neighborhood auto shop. This bill exempts the first \$10,000 of assets from the Business Personal Property Tax, ending a tax that penalizes owners for investing in their own growth and allowing them to keep more of what they earn to reinvest, hire, and serve their communities.

Judicial Reform

We also passed the Judicial Merit Selection Reform Bill (H.4755), which strengthens transparency and reinforces proper separation of powers in South Carolina's judicial selection process. By restoring balance and clarifying authority within the Governor's Office, this reform enhances public trust and ensures greater accountability in how judges are selected. As always, I appreciate the opportunity to represent you and
