The suspects' original vehicle was disabled during the incident and has been recovered by authorities. The victims were transported to a local hospital with minor injuries related to the crash. If you see this vehicle or have any information related to this incident, please contact the KCSO immediately. Suspects should be considered armed and dangerous. Do not approach.

The suspect and victim are known to each other. At this time, investigators have no reason to believe anyone else was involved in the incident. This was not a random act, and there is no indication that the public is in danger.

Per Coroner Karla Deese: On May 27, 2026, just after 8:00pm, Deputy Coroner John Collins and Chief Deputy Coroner Jennifer Collins responded to the intersection of SC Highway 5 and Riverside Rd. in Lancaster, SC in reference to a two-vehicle collision. The collision involved a Ford pick-up truck, and a 4-door Audi sedan.

The Ford pick-up truck was occupied by 4 men. Upon collision, the vehicle was overturned. Two of the truck occupants were pronounced deceased on scene and the other two truck occupants were transported for medical care, and their condition is unknown at this time. The decedents have been identified as 41-year-old Miguel Angel Trujillo Valdivia of Charlotte, NC and 27-year-old Vincente Silverio Rosales of Charlotte, NC.

The Audi sedan was occupied with 2 people who were transported from the scene to receive medical care and their condition is unknown.

The incident is being investigated by South Carolina Highway Patrol and the Lancaster County Coroner's Office. No further details are available at this time.
