Carl Albert finishes strong at Holiday Classic

Carl Albert made its annual trip to the Holiday Classic in Mustang last week, once again facing a stacked field of top teams from large and small schools.

The Titans entered the tournament undefeated with hopes of bringing home the championship,

but those aspirations ended with an 89-53 loss to host Mustang in the semifinals at the Mustang Activity Center.

Carl Albert may have saved its best performance for the final day of competition. In the third-place game against Jenks, the Titans rolled to a convincing 79-45 victory.

Austin Johnson led the

way with 21 points on 6-of-9 shooting. He went 3 of 4 from 3-point range and knocked down all six of his free-throw attempts.

Delijah Matthews added 12 points, while Gibson Johnson and LeBron Royal each chipped in 10. Carl Albert also dominated the glass, outrebounding Jenks 36-15.

Coach Jay Price was


pleased with the way his team responded after being handled by Mustang the night before.

"We played much better," Price said. "Especially coming off a late-night loss, and especially the manner we lost. We got thumped pretty good by Mustang, and having to come back and play an
