Stat. § 12-218, only allows law enforcement and authorized emergency vehicles to have certain audible and visual signals on a vehicle, including red, white or blue, or a combination of red, white or blue lights flashing lights and audible sirens. Only persons who are authorized under Oklahoma law to possess vehicles with the flashing lights and siren currently installed on the Vehicle are qualified to submit bids. If the Mustang Chief of Police cannot confirm a bidder's authority to possess a vehicle with currently installed flashing lights and siren, then the submitted bid shall be rejected as not meeting the bid specifications. The decision of the Mustang Chief of Police as to authorization of the bidder to possess vehicles with the installed flashing lights and siren Purchaser shall be final.
