in the Office of the City Clerk, Council Chambers, City Hall, at 1501 N. Mustang Rd, Mustang Oklahoma 73064, until 10:00 a.m., Central Mountain Time, on the 5th day of February, 2026.

Bidders may submit a bid price for one or more vehicles, but shall indicate the bid price separately for each vehicle. Bids must meet or exceed the Reserve shown above for the respective Vehicle. Bids shall be opened at the above stated time for receipt of Bids or as soon thereafter as practicable. The bids will be awarded per vehicle.

Oklahoma law, 47 Okla. Stat. § 12-218, only allows law enforcement and authorized emergency vehicles to have certain audible and visual signals on a vehicle, including red, white or blue, or a combination of red, white or blue lights flashing lights and audible sirens. Only persons who are authorized under Oklahoma law to possess vehicles with the flashing lights and siren currently installed on the Vehicle are qualified to submit bids. If the Mustang Chief of Police cannot confirm a bidder's authority to possess a vehicle with currently installed flashing lights and siren, then the submitted bid shall be rejected as not meeting the bid specifications. The decision of the Mustang Chief of Police as to authorization of the bidder to possess vehicles with the installed flashing lights and siren Purchaser shall be final.

All vehicles are offered for sale "AS IS, WHERE IS," and the City of Mustang makes no warranty, guaranty or representation of any kind, expressed or implied, regarding the vehicles, including any warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose. Bidders must adhere to the inspection dates and times indicated in the item description.

By submitting a bid, Bidder agrees they have read, fully understand and accept the Terms and Conditions and the Notice of Solicitation of Bids for Used Vehicles. The Terms and Conditions are available for public inspection and copies may be obtained by visiting the City Clerk, 1501 N. Mustang Road, Mustang, Oklahoma 73064. Each bid submitted is a legal offer and, when accepted by the City, constitutes a FIRM AND BINDING CONTRACT.

Each bid must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing on the outside: (1) the name of the bidder; (2) the bidder's address; and (3) reference to the Solicitation for Bids for Used Vehicles. If forwarded by mail, the sealed envelope containing the bid must be enclosed in another envelope addressed as specified in the bid form. All blank spaces for bid prices must be completed in ink or typewritten and in both words and figures. Bids received more than ninety-six (96) hours, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, before the time set for opening of bids, as well as bids received after the time set for receipt of bids, WILL NOT be considered and will be RETURNED UNOPENED.

The City reserves the right to: (a) REJECT ANY or ALL BIDS; (b) Withdraw any or all vehicles offered for sale from this solicitation; (c) For live auctions, regulate bidding on any auction including, but not limited to, refusing to accept any bid or facilitating automatic bids on behalf of Buyers; and (d) Delay or rescind the sale of any Asset for any reason.

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
