ORDER AUTHORIZING TRANSPORT

Now on this 4th day of February 2026, this matter comes before the Court. The Court found that, based upon the letter from Red Rock Behavioral Health Services dated January 12, 2026 and filed on January 23, 2026, the Defendant refused to complete the competency evaluation via video conference (telehealth) and that the evaluator "believes Mr. Hale is likely incompetent and is a person requiring treatment due to his mental state and the severity of his symptoms."

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Grady County Sheriff's Department is hereby authorized and ordered to transport the Defendant to Oklahoma Forensic Center located at 24800 South 4420 Rd., Vinita, OK 74301 for any necessary further evaluation and treatment. Prior to transport, the Grady County Sheriff's Office shall coordinate with Oklahoma Forensic Center to ensure an evaluator/appointment for evaluation is available. Upon confirmation of availability, the Grady County Sheriff's Office shall transport the Defendant to Oklahoma Forensic Center located at 24800 South 4420 Rd., Vinita, OK 74301 and remain with the Defendant until he evaluated or is admitted to Oklahoma Forensic Center.

The Defendant shall not be released from Oklahoma Forensic Center without first giving notice to the Court (Judge Lowe at 405-224-5564), the Defendant's attorney (Devin Giddens or Al Hoch at 405-521-1155), the Grady County District Attorney's Office (Alyssa Cross at 405-224-4770) and the Grady County Sheriff's Office (Sabra Martin at 405-222-5085) so plans can be made to transport the Defendant back to the Grady County Detention Center. Upon completion of evaluation, Defendant is not to be released to anyone other than the Grady Detention Center/Grady County Sheriff's Office.
