The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Gary Bray made a motion to approve the minutes from January 28, 2026 Special Commissioner's meeting. It was seconded by Ruth Bingham. AYE: Zachary Davis, Ruth Bingham, and Gary Bray.

He informed the Commissioners about the Natural Gas Blow out in Grady County last week and the company Staghorn will be at Winter Creek golf course to help the people that were dealing with evacuation to see if they could help them recoup some of their expenses. Bill stated that he was impressed on how well everyone worked together and kept everyone safe; as well as, he was

keeping the news stations informed. Kim Duke informed the Board that they had 2 personnel at the scene of the Blow out for monitoring. There were other fire fighters there at different times for support. She stated that they had a CPR class and a Ropes Course Class on Saturday. Bobby Cantu stated that he has finalized the Annual 300 Form and will be working on inspecting Fire Extinguishers this week. Bobby informed the Board that the Wild Land Fire training is set for February 5 at Rush Springs.

Commissioner Bingham stated that she spoke to the construction crew and they are working on the 3rd story at the church building, the Sheriff's building, and they are waiting on the air conditioner bid for District #3.

Audience Participation: Ms. Georgia Nelson and Cora Nelson with The Grady County 4-H presented the Commissioners with some cookies in appreciation for their support with 4-H.

Ruth Bingham made a motion to approve the following draw request from the Grady Memorial Hospital's sales tax accounts held with First National Bank: Industry Systems - Computers {10} - \$10,382.55. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Ruth Bingham, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve an acceptance of the Trust Indenture for The Southwest Oklahoma Drug Addiction Trust. It was seconded by Ruth Bingham. AYE: Zachary Davis, Ruth Bingham, and Gary Bray.

No action to approve implementing the burn ban for Grady County for either 7 or 14 days, effective February 2, 2026. The Board would like to put it back on the agenda next Monday.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve a private burial in rural Grady County. It was seconded by Ruth Bingham. AYE: Zachary Davis, Ruth Bingham, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to table the action on a Special Assessment Invoice from OPEH&W Health Plan. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Ruth Bingham, and Gary Bray.

Mr. Brewer spoke to the Board about the furniture that the Sheriff wanted to buy for 3 offices. The Board after speaking with the State Auditor, did not feel like it was something that they could pay for out of Capital Improvement.

Zachary Davis made a motion to table a quote from STOWS for Office furniture in the amount of \$21,352.00 plus delivery costs, and to determine what account it is to be paid for out of. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Ruth Bingham, and Gary Bray.
