The Minco WWTP is a municipal facility that accepts domestic wastewater. The proposed discharge consists of effluent from the Minco WWTP. The discharge from Outfall 001, which is located at latitude 35° 18' 58.900" N, longitude 97° 55' 30.042" W (GPS: NAD83) in Grady County, Oklahoma, will be to Buggy Creek, a tributary to the Canadian River. The sewage sludge generated by the facility is self-contained within the lagoon system.
