ORDINANCE NO. 852

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BLANCHARD, OKLAHOMA AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; AMENDING SECTIONS 4-101 OF ARTICLE ONE (1) OF CHAPTER FOUR (4) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF BLANCHARD, OKLAHOMA, AS AMENDED, CONCERNING BUILDING CODES ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF BLANCHARD, OKLAHOMA; DECLARING REPEALER; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLANCHARD, OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. That Section 4-101 of Article 1 of Chapter 4 of The Code of Ordinances of the City of Blanchard is hereby amended to read as follows:

§ 4-101 CODES ADOPTED.

The particular model codes listed below (with revisions as may be hereinafter set forth) are hereby adopted and incorporated in this code of ordinances, as fully as if set out at length herein, for the purposes of establishing rules and regulations for the following activities carried on within the corporate limits of the city of Blanchard, Oklahoma. The effective versions of these codes shall be the same as the effective versions as adopted by the Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission, and shall immediately be amended in conjunction with adoption of new versions by the Commission, notwithstanding that any amendments made in this chapter shall still prevail, unless specifically modified by Ordinance.

- 1. Building Code. The construction, alteration, removal, demolition, equipment, use, occupancy, location and maintenance of buildings and structures:
a. International Building Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council;
2. Existing Building Code. The alteration, change of use or occupancy classification, re-establishment of occupancy of existing buildings and structures:
a. International Existing Building Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council;
3. Plumbing Code. The installation or alteration of plumbing and drainage systems for buildings and structures:
a. International Plumbing Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council;
4. Electrical Code. The installation or alteration of electrical equipment for buildings or structures:
a. National Electric Code (NEC). Current edition, published by National Fire Protection Association, for both residential and commercial structures;
5. Housing Code. The provisions of basic, minimum housing standards for the preservation of the health, safety and welfare of occupants:
a. International Residential Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council;
6. Fire Prevention Code. The provision of basic safeguards to life and property from the hazards of fire and explosion:
a. International Fire Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council;
7. Gas Codes. The installation or alteration of gas systems for buildings or structures:
a. International Fuel Gas Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council;
8. Energy Conservation Code. The provision of basic standards for energy conservation in buildings and structures:
a. International Energy Conservation Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council;
9. Mechanical Code. The provision of basic standards for mechanical installations in buildings and structures:
a. International Mechanical Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council.
10. Property Maintenance Code. The provision of basic standards governing the maintenance of existing buildings:
a. International Property Maintenance Code. Current edition, published by International Code Council.

SECTION 2. REPEALER.

All former ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

In the event any word or sentence in this ordinance, or provision or portion of this ordinance, or rules adopted by this ordinance is invalidated by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining words and/or sentences, provisions, or portions thereof shall not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.

It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, peace, and safety of the City of Blanchard and the inhabitants thereof, an emergency is hereby declared to exist by reason whereof, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as provided by law.

PASSED and APPROVED and the Emergency Clause voted upon separately and PASSED and APPROVED this 10th day of March, 2026.
