Golf Mustang seeks consistency as postseason nears

More than midway through the season, the Mustang golf team is starting to get busy. A glance at their schedule, it almost feels like they have events seemingly every other day.

But that is a good problem for the Broncos to have as they strive to improve each time out.

"The girls are playing ok," Mustang coach Joel Heath said. "They still have not played their best golf yet. I'm hoping that we play our best golf at Regionals and then at State. If we do that, we should be able to go to state as a team, instead of one individual."

Last week, the Mustang girls placed 10th at the Del City Invite after scoring a 342. They were 52 strokes behind first-place Norman North.

Kayla Ingerson and Kiersten Mai were the top performers for MHS. They each posted a score of 82, which was good for 21st place.

"We are still leaving shots on the course, too many three putts and double chips," Mustang coach Joel Heath said. "We could have easily eliminated 20 team strokes. Kayla Ingerson and Kiersten Mai performed the best."

Ingerson has been solid for the Lady Broncos throughout the season, according to Heath.

"Kayla Ingerson is my one

bag and consistently has the team's low score, but she still has not played her best golf yet," Heath said. "She has the capability to go pretty low if she is in the zone."

For the Mustang boys, the season hasn't been as consistent as they would like. Coming off a third-place finish at the Bronco Spring Bash, they placed 13th at the Tiger Invitational on Monday.

"The season has been a little up and down," said Heath. "Like the girls, they have not played their best golf yet. I have 7-8 guys competing for the top five

varsity spots. I've seen improvement, but we are still leaving shots on the course."

One of the Broncos who has displayed the consistency Heath is looking for is Johnathan Benton, who sits in the No. 1 spot on the team.

"Johnathan has played very well this season," Heath said. "I can only think of one bad round for him. If we include the fall season, he has personally won three

tournaments as an individual. He is doing his job as the one bag."

Others who have had their moments include Zachary Grubbs, Dalton Ochoa and Brody Deaver.

Mustang has just three weeks left in their season. The postseason begins April 20 with the girls' regional tournament at the Lake Hefner Golf Club. The boys' regional is scheduled

for April 27 at the Earlywine Golf Club.

The 6A State Championships are set for May 4-5 (girls) and May 11-12 (boys).

"First and foremost, we have to find the five players playing the best going into regionals," Heath said. "Going into regionals, we need to be playing our best golf and finish our season on a very high note."

Track Mustang sweeps titles at OU meet

The Mustang boys and girls track teams didn't face much competition at the annual John Jacobs Invitational. With only three other teams in the field (Southmoore, Southeast, Tulsa NOAH), the Broncos were mostly scrimmaging against themselves in some cases.

Despite that, MHS made the most of the opportunity and picked up tournament titles for

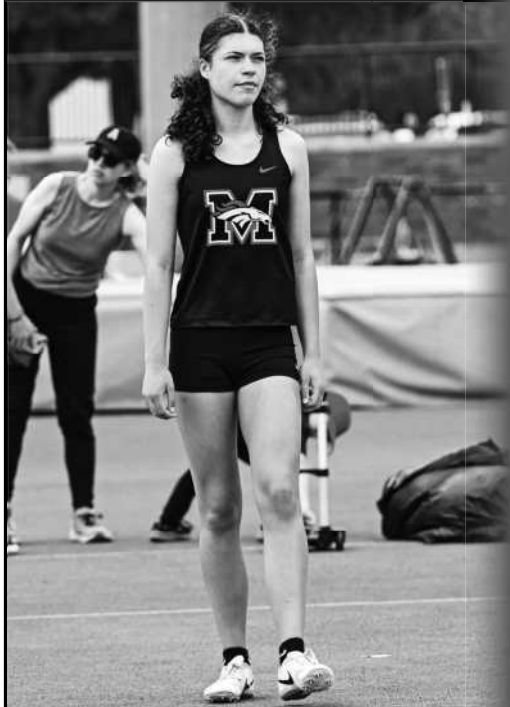
both the boys and girls.

Individual winners on

the boys' side included Jordan Brownlee (100 meters), Jonathan McCorvey (110 hurdles), Sebastain Koch (Pole Vault) and Gabriel Osborne Jr. (Long jump).

For the MHS girls, it was an even bigger haul. Kamyah Penn (100, 200 meters), Moriah Young (400), Abigail Izquierdo (100 hurdles), Kennedy Roberts (3,200 meters), Amy Drabenstot (high jump) and Kaitlyn Nelson (Pole Vault) all claimed gold.
