SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE

Under and by virtue of Section 27 of Article X, of the Oklahoma Constitution and the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma, and Acts complementary, supplementary, and enacted pursuant thereto, and Ordinance No. 06-01-2026B dated June 1, 2026, authorizing the calling of an election on the proposition hereinafter set forth, I, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Del City, Oklahoma, hereby call a special election and give notice thereof to be held in the City of Del City, Oklahoma, on the 25th day of August, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the registered, qualified voters in said City the following proposition:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Public Safety Projects

Shall the City of Del City, State of Oklahoma, incur an indebtedness by issuing its general obligation bonds in the sum of Three Million Dollars (\$3,000,000) to provide funds for the purpose of acquiring and equipping firefighting vehicles, police vehicles, and improvements to the outdoor warning system, all to be owned exclusively by the City, to be completed with or without the use of other funds, and levy and collect an annual tax, in addition to all other taxes, upon all the taxable property in said City sufficient to pay the interest on said bonds as it falls due, and also to constitute a sinking fund for the payment of the principal thereof when due, said bonds to be competitively sold and bear interest at the lowest rate not to exceed ten percentum (10%) per annum, payable semi-annually and to become due within five (5) years from their date?

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECTS AND USE OF PROCEEDS

(Proposition No. 1)

Public Safety Projects

The Public Safety Projects for which the proceeds of the aforesaid not to exceed \$3,000,000 general obligation bonds shall be expended consist of acquiring and equipping firefighting vehicles, police vehicles, and improvements to the outdoor warning system, all to be owned exclusively by the City. The projects may be accomplished through participation with other governmental agencies and others, and may be accomplished in phases. The specific projects for which at least seventy percent (70%) of the proceeds of the aforesaid bonds shall be expended and the dollar amount of each such project shall be as follows:

Acquisition and equipping of a new Fire Pumper Truck

\$1,465,000

Acquisition and equipping of ten (10) new police vehicles

\$740,000

Acquisition and equipping of a fire brush rescue vehicle

\$300,000

Acquisition and installation of upgraded outdoor warning system components, including sirens, park speakers, and communication and control system

\$290,000

Estimated costs of issuance and contingency funds. Any funds not required to complete the foregoing projects shall be utilized for the purpose of acquiring and equipping firefighting vehicles, police vehicles, and improvements to the outdoor warning system, all to be owned exclusively by the City

\$205,000

That only the registered, qualified voters of the City of Del City, Oklahoma, may vote upon the proposition as above set forth.
