SPECIAL ELECTION PROCLAMATION AND NOTICE

Under and by virtue of the Statutes of the State of Oklahoma, and Acts complementary, supplementary, and enacted pursuant thereto, and Resolution No. 2026-94-CC of the City of Blanchard, Oklahoma, dated June 9, 2026, authorizing the calling of an election on the proposition hereinafter set forth, I, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Blanchard, Oklahoma, hereby call a special election and give notice thereof to be held in the City of Blanchard, Oklahoma, on the 25th day of August, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the registered, qualified voters in said City, the following proposition:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Capital Expenditures Sales Tax

Shall the City of Blanchard be authorized to extend the levy and collection of an existing City excise tax (sales tax) of one percent (1.0%) currently expiring June 30, 2027, which tax is in addition to all other City, County, and State excise taxes presently being levied or assessed, upon the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all sales taxable under the Oklahoma Sales Tax Code; providing the proceeds of such tax shall be used to fund capital expenditures benefitting the City, and/or for the payment of debt service in connection with obligations heretofore issued or to be issued to finance or refinance said capital expenditures and related costs; providing that capital expenditures shall be interpreted broadly and shall include but not be limited to, the construction and equipping of water, wastewater and storm drainage system improvements; animal shelter; public tornado shelter; community center; public safety facilities, vehicles, and equipment; parks and recreation facilities; and/or municipal buildings; providing said excise tax shall be levied beginning July 1, 2027, and have no stated termination date; all as more specifically set out in Ordinance No. 862 of the City?

The voting machines or devices used at said election shall set out the proposition as above set forth and shall also contain the words:

☐ NO – AGAINST THE ABOVE PROPOSITION

That only the registered, qualified voters of the City of Blanchard, Oklahoma, may vote upon the propositions as above set forth.

The polls shall be opened at 7:00 o'clock a.m. and shall remain open continuously until and be closed at 7:00 o'clock p.m.

Such election shall be conducted by those precinct officers designated by the County Election Board of McClain County, Oklahoma, which officers shall also act as counters and certify the results thereof as required by law.

As provided in Title 26, Oklahoma Statutes Section 13-103, the City authorizes the McClain County Election Board to open all precinct polling places for Blanchard municipal elections located in Grady County, Oklahoma, and McClain County, Oklahoma, for this election.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-94-CC

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CALLING AND HOLDING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF BLANCHARD, STATE OF OKLAHOMA (THE "CITY"), ON THE 25TH DAY OF AUGUST, 2026, FOR

THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTION OR REJECTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 862 OF THE CITY RELATING TO THE EXTENSION OF A ONE PERCENT (1.0%) EXCISE TAX (SALES TAX) CURRENTLY EXPIRING JUNE 30, 2027, WHICH TAX IS IN ADDITION TO ALL PRESENT CITY, COUNTY AND STATE EXCISE TAXES, WITH THE PROCEEDS OF SAID TAX TO BE USED TO FUND CAPITAL EXPENDITURES OF THE CITY, OR DEBT SERVICE IN CONNECTION WITH SAID CAPITAL EXPENDITURES, AS MORE SPECIFICALLY SET OUT IN ORDINANCE NO. 862 OF SAID CITY; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED THERETO.

WHEREAS, it is deemed advisable and necessary by the City Council of the City of Blanchard, Oklahoma (the “City”) to submit to the registered qualified electors of the City the question of approval or rejection of Ordinance No. 862 of the City pertaining to the levy and collection of a one percent (1.0%) excise tax (sales tax) for the purpose of funding capital expenditures benefitting the City, and/or for the payment of debt service in connection with obligations heretofore issued or to be issued to finance or refinance said capital expenditures and related costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLANCHARD, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. Proposition. That the Mayor of the City be, or in his absence or incapacity, the duly qualified Vice Mayor, be and hereby is authorized and directed to call a special election to be held in the City on the 25th day of August, 2026, for the purpose of submitting to the registered qualified electors of the City, the following proposition:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

Capital Expenditures Sales Tax

Shall the City of Blanchard be authorized to extend the levy and collection of an existing City excise tax (sales tax) of one percent (1.0%) currently expiring June 30, 2027, which tax is in addition to all other City, County, and State excise taxes presently being levied or assessed, upon the gross proceeds or gross receipts derived from all sales taxable under the Oklahoma Sales Tax Code; providing the proceeds of such tax shall be used to fund capital expenditures benefitting the City, and/or for the payment of debt service in connection with obligations heretofore issued or to be issued to finance or refinance said capital expenditures and related costs; providing that capital expenditures shall be interpreted broadly and shall include but not be limited to, the construction and equipping of water, wastewater and storm drainage system improvements; animal shelter; public tornado shelter; community center; public safety facilities, vehicles, and equipment; parks and recreation facilities; and/or municipal buildings; providing said excise tax shall be levied beginning July 1, 2027, and have no stated termination date; all as more specifically set out in Ordinance No. 862 of the City?

The voting machines or devices used at said election shall set out the proposition as above set forth and shall also contain the words:

Section 2. Election Proclamation. That such call for said election shall be by proclamation and notice, signed by the Mayor or Vice Mayor of the City and attested by the City Clerk, setting forth the proposition to be voted upon and the hours of opening and closing of the polls. That the ballots shall set forth the proposition to be voted upon substantially as set out in Section 1 hereof, and that the returns of said election shall be made to and canvassed by the McClain County Election Board. As provided in Title 26, Oklahoma Statutes Section 13-103, the City authorizes the McClain County Election Board to open all precinct polling places for Blanchard municipal elections located in Grady County, Oklahoma and McClain County, Oklahoma, for this election.

Section 3. Service on County Election Board. That the City Clerk shall serve or cause to be served, a copy of this Resolution and the Special Election Proclamation and Notice upon the office of the McClain County Election Board as required by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 862

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE LEVY OF A ONE PERCENT SALES TAX WHICH TAX IS CURRENTLY LEVIED AND AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2007-01, IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER STATE, COUNTY AND CITY SALES TAXES UPON THE GROSS PROCEEDS OR GROSS RECEIPTS DERIVED FROM ALL SALES TO ANY PERSON TAXABLE UNDER THE SALES TAX LAW OF OKLAHOMA INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CERTAIN ENUMERATED SALES LISTED THEREIN; PROVIDING FOR SUBSISTING STATE PERMITS; PROVIDING FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE TAX AND EARMARKING THE SAME; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE AND NO STATED TERMINATION DATE; INCORPORATING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF EXISTING CITY ORDINANCES; AUTHORIZING CITY COUNCIL TO MAKE ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL CHANGES AND ADDITIONS; MAKING THE TAX CUMULATIVE; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY OF PROVISIONS; REQUIRING APPROVAL OF THIS ORDINANCE BY A MAJORITY OF REGISTERED QUALIFIED ELECTORS VOTING AT AN ELECTION HELD FOR SUCH PURPOSE AS PROVIDED BY LAW; AND CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATED THERETO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLANCHARD, OKLAHOMA:

Section 1. Citation and Codification. This Ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the “City of Blanchard Sales Tax Ordinance of 2027” and shall be codified with the ordinances of the City of Blanchard, Oklahoma (the “City”) and is hereinafter referred to as “Ordinance”. This Ordinance, effective July 1, 2027, and subject to approval by a majority of the qualified electors
