Timothy Milliken

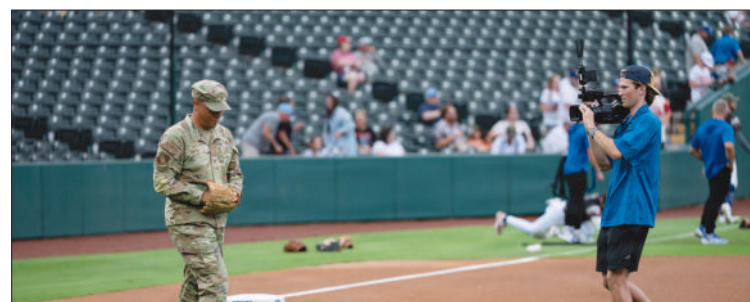

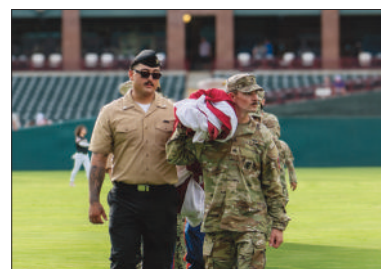
