

Yukon celebrates America's 250th birthday at Freedom Fest 2026

The City of Yukon invites residents and visitors to celebrate Independence Day and a historic milestone as Freedom Fest returns July 3-4, 2026. This year's event carries special significance as communities across the nation commemorate the 250th anniversary of the United States of America.

For two days, Chisholm Trail Park will transform into the heart of Yukon's Independence Day celebration, featuring live entertainment, family activities, patriotic tributes, food vendors, community traditions, and spectacular drone and fireworks displays.

The celebration will begin the evening of Friday, July 3. Come enjoy food vendors, family activity areas, live music

from the Hi-Fi Hillbillies and Winds of the Prairie, a special Veterans Tribute honoring local veterans, and the unveiling of a community mosaic mural. Fireworks and a drone show will cap of the night.

Activities continue Saturday, July 4, at 10 a.m. with the Freedom Fest Car Show. Families can enjoy children's activities including a petting zoo, inflatable water slides, and a craft area, along with live entertainment, food vendors, the annual Hot Dog Eating Contest, and free public swim at City Splash. Guests can also register to compete in the Freedom Fest Cornhole Tournament.

Complimentary watermelon and ice cream will be served

during the evening festivities, which feature live performances by Jukebox Heroes and Superfreak before Freedom Fest concludes with an Independence Day Drone Show and fireworks finale.

All Freedom Fest activities will take place at Chisholm Trail Park, 500 W. Vandament Avenue, and admission is free. Residents are encouraged to bring lawn chairs and join the Yukon community in celebrating 250 years of American independence.
