**Rules and Regulations:**

1. Please call the Extension Office (735-2900) by June 25 to pre-register.
  2. All birds must be inspected and free of disease, parasites, etc. and certified Pullorum free prior to being accepted for competition. Free on-site testing will be conducted prior to show.
  3. Exhibition cages will be provided.
  4. Exhibitor limited to one entry per lot.
  5. Though every precaution will be taken, neither the Smith County Fair nor any individual working this event, will be responsible for the injury or loss of any bird.
  6. All poultry exhibitors and drivers of vehicles transporting poultry show entries will be admitted free and must travel together.
  7. All birds must be removed from the Fair Grounds following the completion of the show.
  8. In recognition of the America 250 Celebration, the Smith County Fair invites exhibitors to help honor our nation's heritage by adding a patriotic theme to select livestock shows. Participation is encouraged but optional.
- Premiums: 1st place \$5, 2nd place \$3, 3rd place \$2 Best of Class \$5 Best of Show Overall: \$10**
- First place winners in each lot will compete for Best of Class. Best of Class winners will compete for Best of Show Overall at the end of the show.

Champion in each class will receive a \$20 Tractor Supply gift card, and overall Grand Champion will receive a \$25 gift card, courtesy of Tractor Supply Company in Carthage.



**AMERICA 250 PATRIOTIC SHOWCASE**

In recognition of the America 250 Celebration, the Smith County Fair invites exhibitors to help honor our nation's heritage by adding a patriotic theme to our livestock shows. Participation is encouraged but optional.

**GENERAL GUIDELINES:**

- Patriotic themes should reflect American pride, including red, white, and blue; stars and stripes; military, agriculture, or historical themes.
- Animal comfort and safety are the top priority.
- No paint, dye, adhesives, or materials may be applied directly to animals.
- Costumes and decorations must not interfere with animal movement, vision, breathing, or showmanship.
- The show committee reserves the right to remove any decoration or attire deemed unsafe or inappropriate.

**Patriotic Cage Decoration Contest**

Poultry exhibitors are encouraged to decorate their cages with an America 250 patriotic theme. Decorations must be placed on the outside of the cage and must not interfere with ventilation, feeding, or bird comfort.

Awards will be presented for creativity, originality, and patriotic spirit.
