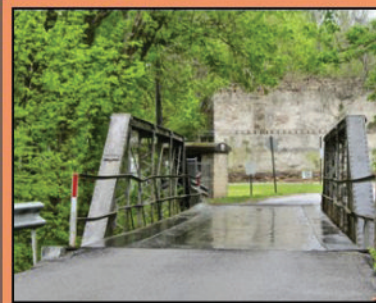
to Calico Rock.

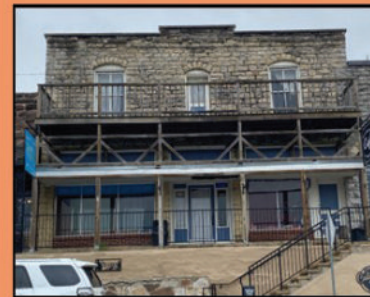

in East Historic District



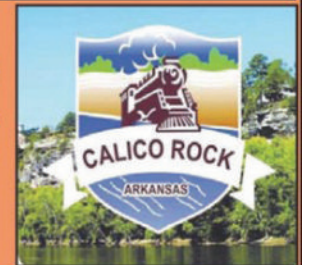
