

# Enjoy paradise in Norfolk



A place you hear about but seldom have the opportunity to see. Norfolk is located in a beautiful valley in north central Arkansas where the White River is joined by the North Fork River. It is reputed to be one of the finest trout fishing areas in the United States, possibly the world. Featuring Rainbow, Cutthroat, Brook and of course

our record-setting Brown trout. The town was established adjacent to the Wolf House, (c 1829), which is the oldest public structure still standing in Arkansas. Built near where the White and North Fork Rivers merge, it has served thousands of early settlers finding their way into the central highlands of north Arkansas. People from

the surrounding area would set up temporary quarters on the grounds to socialize and participate in their favorite activities while court was in session. Now it is open to visit and walk through Tuesday-Saturday, 8:00 am-4:30 pm, with daily tours available from 10am and 2pm. Visiting the Jacob Wolf House Historic site you are experiencing history where it happened!

Or take a drive down to the bottom of Quarry Dam to check out the Norfolk National Fish Hatchery. At the hatchery, you can learn about the local trout production and have fun too! Learn about all the stages of trout production and the interesting information on trout in the White River Region. Visit the visitors' center with some

native animals, informative materials, and stop at the gift shop for a fun shopping experience. Atop the dam is Norfolk Lake, built between 1941-44 by the US Army Corp or Engineers, the lake encompasses forty two miles of crystal blue freshwater with over 540 miles of undisturbed shoreline. Norfolk Lake is one of the cleanest lakes in the nation that features fishing for prime bass, crappie and walleye.

Explore the beautiful bluffs, Ozark sunsets, and rolling hills around Norfolk Lake or dive below to explore some of the underwater treasures that draw divers from all over. Whether it's a fishing trip with old friends or a weekend getaway by the water, there is something for everyone in Norfolk.
