imals and we got to go fishing."

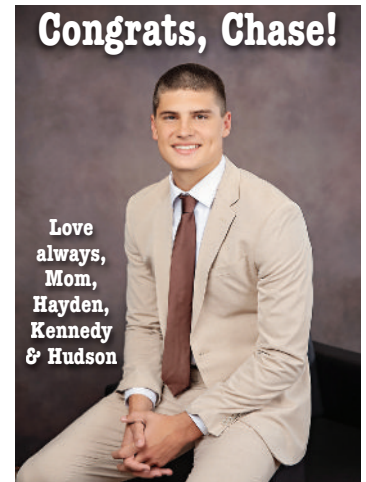
"I loved my biology class because we had so much fun, laughed a bunch, and had a small class so we all got along," said Gracie Luhring.
