trends coming from social media, global waste is expected to grow by around 70% by 2050 if trends continue.

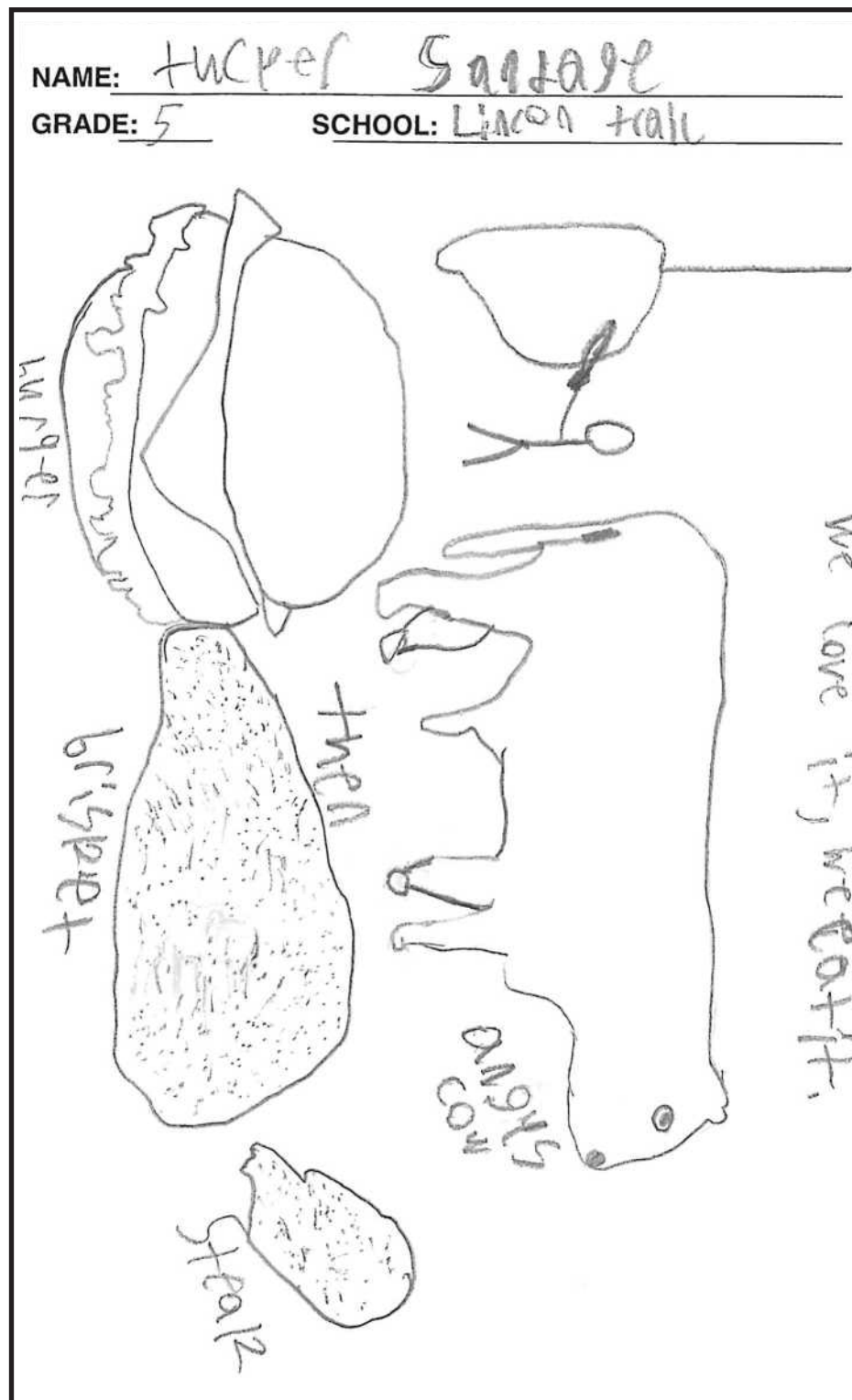
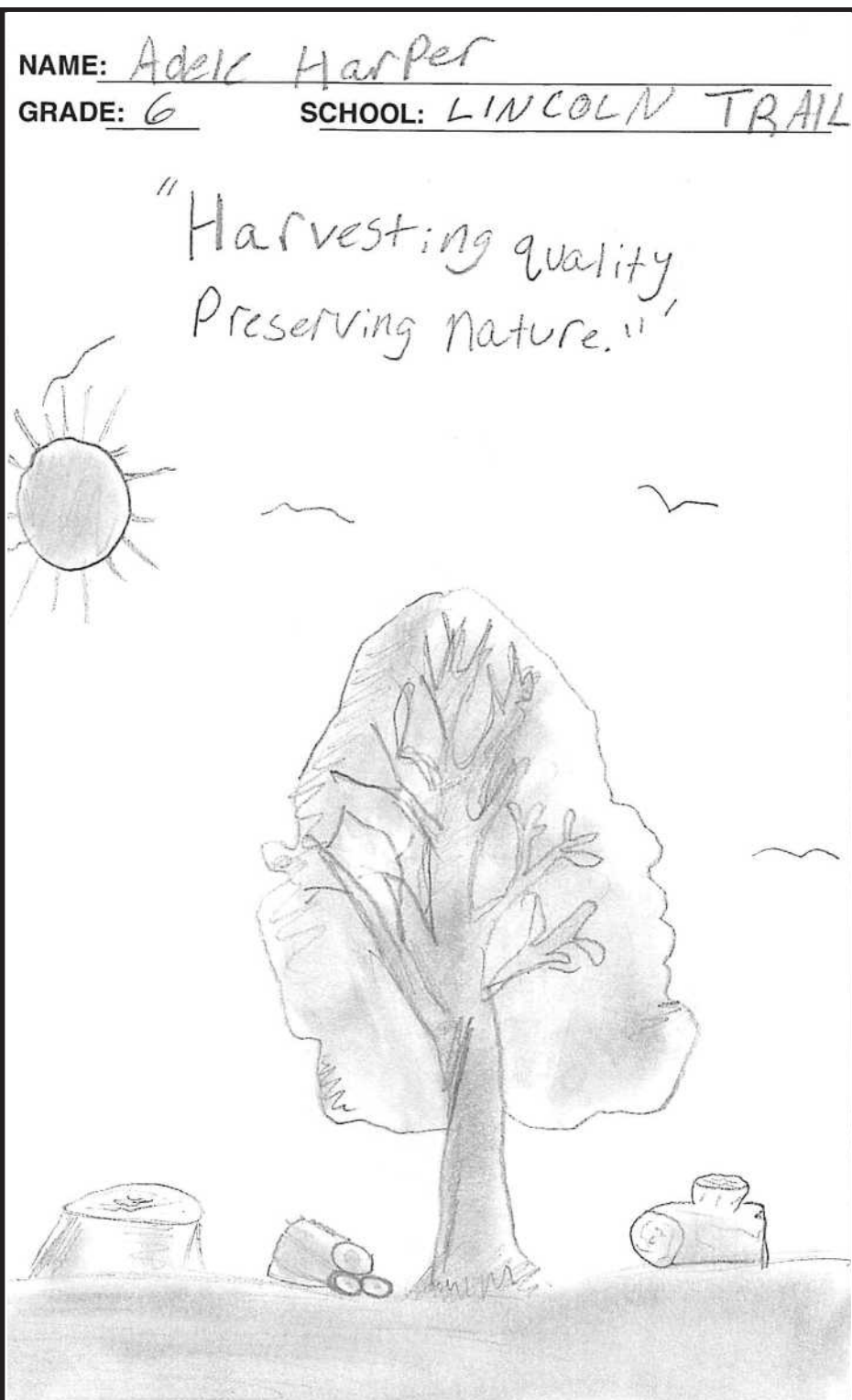
Social Media
