

# Dragons lose to Washington County

The Dragons lost in the first round of the 5th Region All A Tournament last week to Washington County, 71-69. That loss drops their season record to 3-10.

Despite getting off to a slow start, the Dragons held a three-point lead at halftime.

The first half was extremely close as there were ten ties and eight lead changes in the game until Washington County took their largest lead at nine points with 1:52 to go in the third quarter.

But the Dragons did not quit. They cut the lead down to four before the Commanders scored the last four points of the quarter to lead by eight heading into the final quarter.

With 1:13 to go in the game, the Dragons cut the lead to just four but free throw shooting allowed the Commander to secure the win.

During the fourth quarter, Washington County attempted 19

free throws, hitting 13 of them, and that prevented the Dragons from getting any closer until they picked up a bucket at the end of the game to trail by two.

Paxton Bloyd represented Green County on the All Tournament Team and Braxton Judd was named Player of the Game by gng productions who was televising the game.

This game was also the first game for transfer Kai Wade who has recently been ruled eligible by the KHSAA.
