

## Lady Dragons in All A State Tournament today

The Green County Lady Dragons play Bishop Brossart this morning at 11:30 a.m. at the Owensboro Sportscenter in the first round of the All "A" Classic State Tournament.

Green County defeated Washington County, Fort Knox and Bethlehem to win the 5th Region Tournament.

Bishop Brossart, out

of the 10th Region in northern Kentucky, defeated Augusta, Bracken County and Nicholas County to win their region.

The Lady 'Stangs advanced to last year's semifinals of the All "A" Classic state tournament before losing to Bethlehem.

Bishop Brossart's win in the 10th Region championship gave them a 17-1 record. Their only loss has been to Campbell County, the top-rated

team in their region according to the RPI.

Green County and Bishop Brossart have not played each other, but they did have a chance to see each other in action during the Lady Invitational of the South in December at Allen County-Scottsville High School.

Bishop Brossart won all four of their games in the tournament to win the championship.

Both teams beat Madisonville-North

Hopkins, but Green County lost to Allen County-Scottsville and Hopkins County Central, two teams that the Lady 'Stangs defeated.

This marks the 9th time that a team coached by Chris Blaydes has played in the All "A" Classic. They were state runner-up in 2009. Green County went four times before Blaydes took over as coach.

Bishop Brossart has been a total of 14 times. They were the

1999 champions and finished as runner-up in 1998 and 2000.

The Lady 'Stangs are led by sophomore Kylie Smith who averages 18.4 points per game and 6.3 rebounds. Junior Graylee Kramer averages 12.3 points per game and 4.5 rebounds.

The Lady Dragons are led by sophomore Scout Brockman who averages 18.3 points per contest and 8.7 rebounds. Molly Dixon averages 12.1 points

per game and 6.2 rebounds. Chloe Fortner, the other Lady Dragon in double figures, averages 10.5 points per game and 5.6 rebounds.

Bishop Brossart hits 46.2% of their shots compared to Green County's 44.6%. The Lady 'Stangs hit 29.4% of the three-point shots while the Lady Dragons average hitting 26.3% of their long range shots.

The winner advances to Friday's quarter-final round.

## Dragons win three last week, extend winning streak to six

The Lady Dragons had another banner week last week, defeating Thomas Nelson, Caverna and LaRue County. All three wins were by more than 30 points each. Their record is 13-6 heading into today's game in the All A State Tournament in Owensboro against Bishop Brossart. The Lady Dragons are 4-0 in the district race.

The Lady Dragons got off to a great start in this game, putting 25 points on the board in the first quarter even though only three players scored. Chloe Fortner, Brooklyn Jewell and Scout Brockman led the way for the team.

In the second quarter, two more Lady Dragons got in the scoring column and the Lady Dragon defense overpowered their opponents, allowing them to score just three points in the quarter.

That stifling defense continued in the third quarter as the Lady Generals tallied just four points and the quarter ended with the Lady Dragons holding a 34-point lead, just one away from causing the clock to run for the rest of the game.
