Midway through the second period, Green County opened up a six-point lead primarily due to their free throw shooting. During that eight-minute span, the Lady Dragons were nine of 11 from the free three line. Isabella Clopton was eight for eight from the charity stripe in the second period.

Turnovers began to take its toll in the second half, however. During the game, Green County committed 28

turnovers which led to 31 Bishop Brossart points. A very physically strong Lady 'Stangs team committed only 18 turnovers during the game and the Lady Dragons only scored 16 points off those turnovers.

Green County, who usually hits about 26% of their three-point attempts, was only one for eight from beyond the arc. Brooklyn Jewell made that three pointer for the Lady Dragons.

Green County led by one at the end of the

third quarter but some foul trouble and efficient free throw shooting by Bishop Brossart was too much to overcome.

The Lady 'Stangs only hit 17 of 25 free throws during the game, but during the fourth quarter, they picked up 10 points from the foul line.
