

# Dragons win two in a row

For the first time this season, the Dragons have won two games in a row. They defeated Warren East 85-48 and Elizabethtown 83-53. This came on the heels of a narrow loss to LaRue County, the second highest rated team in the 5th Region. Following these two wins, the Dragons are 5-12.

## Green County 85 Warren East 48

The Dragons were on fire starting in the first quarter when they jumped out to a 17-point lead as six different players scored for Green County. The offensive barrage continued in the second quarter for the Dragons, who were on track to score the most points of the season in one game.

During the third quarter, the game was played with a running clock which cut down on the scoring options for the Dragons, who substituted freely allowing nine different

players to score. This win broke a six-game losing streak to the Raiders.

The offense continued to click on all cylinders in the Dragons' game against the Panthers last Tuesday night at home.

E-town began the game with a 7-0 before Green County got on the board, but the Dragons went on a 9-0 run to end the quarter with a five-point advantage.

The second quarter began much like the

first quarter as E-ton scored the first eight points of the period but after that, the Dragon defense tightened up and limited the Panthers to just three points the rest of the quarter.

The Dragons continued to build on their lead through the third quarter and then Green County exploded for 31 points in the last quarter as the Dragons sealed their second consecutive win.
