



The Green County High School Lady Dragons won the 18th District Tournament championship Friday night. They defeated Caverna 70-21 in the semifinals and then beat LaRue County 53-35 in the championship game.

The Lady Dragons are advancing to the 5th Region Tournament this week. Willis has been part of the team for four years and all four years they have played in the region tournament.

LADY DRAGONS WIN DISTRICT TOURNAMENT

For the fourth straight year, the Lady Dragons advanced to the 5th Region Tournament with wins over Caverna in the semifinals and over LaRue in the championship game in last week's 18th District Tournament at Caverna. This moves the Lady Dragons to 23-8 on the year. Last year, Green County was 23-7.

Green County won the district tournament three consecutive years and finished runner-up in 2023.

This game was never in doubt as the Lady Dragons jumped out to a 14-0 lead to begin the game and at the end of the first quarter, Green County held a 30-2 lead against a team that was obviously overpowered but never quit.

Green County has a 28-game winning streak over the Lady Colonels that goes all the way back to January 23, 2015.

The Lady Dragons had only nine eligible players on the bench because two girls are hampered by injuries and one had a class so even though Head Coach Chris Blaydes substituted early and often, there was at least one starter on the floor at all times for the Lady Dragons.

Every player scored for the Lady Dragons during the game.
