Registration is now open for the Kentucky 4-H Teen Conference, to be held June 2nd-5th on the University of Kentucky campus in Lexington. The conference is open to high school students 9-12th grades.

For more than 100 years, the conference has brought teens from across the commonwealth together to develop life skills, leadership competencies and communication abilities. This year's four-day event is hosted by Kentucky 4-H Youth Development and Cooperative Extension Service at the UK Martin-Gatton College of Agriculture, Food and Environment.

In addition to the conference's packed agenda of enriching activities and fun social events, teen delegates will experience the independence of collegiate life while living in dorms, enjoying meals at Champions Kitchen and the 90 and engaging with their peers in academic and student-life facilities on campus.

The scope of the conference encompasses a broad range of interests including art, science and civic engagement with an emphasis on developing confident and capable leadership skills for young people from across the state. Cohorts will include topics including animal science, media, fashion, oral health, field to fork, hook and cook, biology, physics and so much more. There is truly something for everyone.

Featured events at this year's conference will include a fashion revue, the Clover

Fest, a Day of Service volunteering opportunity, state 4-H officer recognition, presentation of the 4-H Emerald Awards, 4-H Achievement Awards recognition and a closing night dance.

The cost to attend this year's conference is \$300 per person. Registration must be completed with the Green County Extension Office by April 10.

4-H Summer Camp for Green County runs the same week, so a chaperone will be needed to take any participating delegates.
