



Dragons sweep Campbellsville Invitational

The Green County High School Boys' and Girls' Track and Field teams won their third meet of the outdoor season, sweeping to victory at the Campbellsville-Durham High School Invitational in Campbellsville.

For the Dragons, they defeated second-place Spencer County, 123-113.

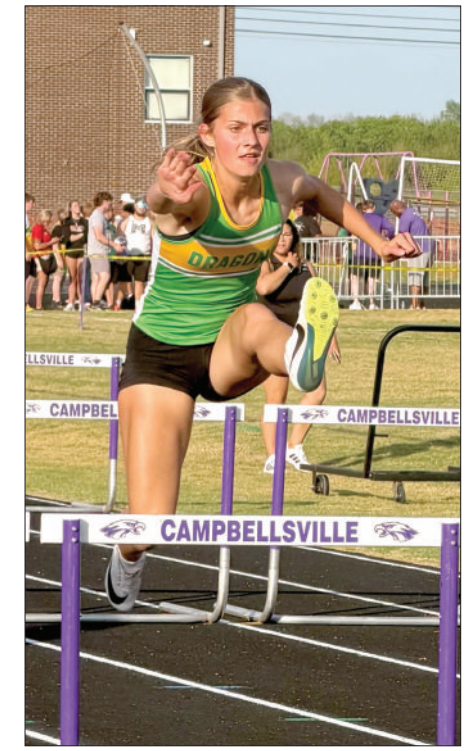
Katie Fields ran the 100m hurdles in a time of 22.19.

The organizer of the event, Katie Henderson, is an above-the-knee amputee who has learned that life isn't over once you become an amputee but instead, it just becomes different.

Henderson, a teacher at Green County Primary School, lost her leg in an accident almost five years ago.

"Every kid in my school knows me and doesn't think anything about my being an amputee," Henderson said.

Because of her teaching position and also because she was on her high school track team, she knows it is important for children to get plenty of exercise but also become aware of people who may look a little different.
