

Lady Dragons split games last week

Green County High School's softball team lost to Elizabethtown last week in a home game but came back to defeat Caverna in an away game. The Lady Dragons are 8-13 after last week and are now in the last three weeks of the regular season.

The Lady Dragons have not beaten Elizabethtown since 2023 when Green County defeated them in the semi-final round of the 5th Region Tournament. Since the 2003 season, while it seems

Green County wasted no time in slugging their way around the diamond as they scored five runs in the first inning, eight in the second inning and three in the third inning, jumping out to a 16-2 lead after three innings. Every player in the lineup connected for a hit and all but two of the players scored in the game.

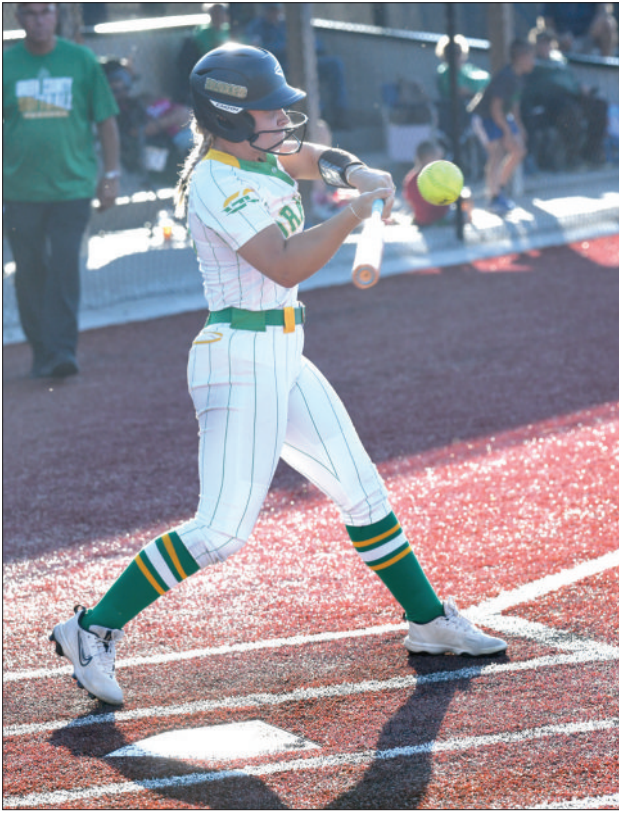

Brooklyn Jewell had one of two Green County hits in their game against Elizabethtown last week at American Legion Park.

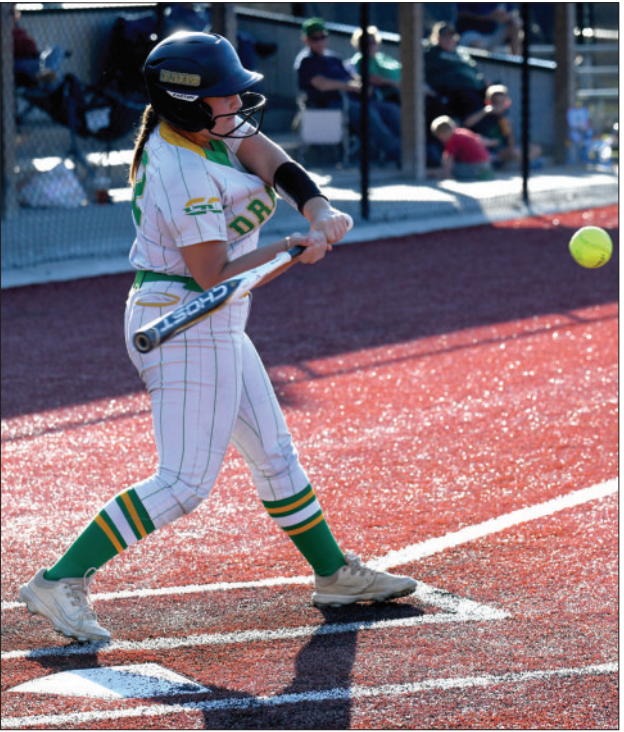

Kylee Hargan takes a big swing against Elizabethtown last week. The Lady Dragons fell 11-0 to the Lady Panthers.

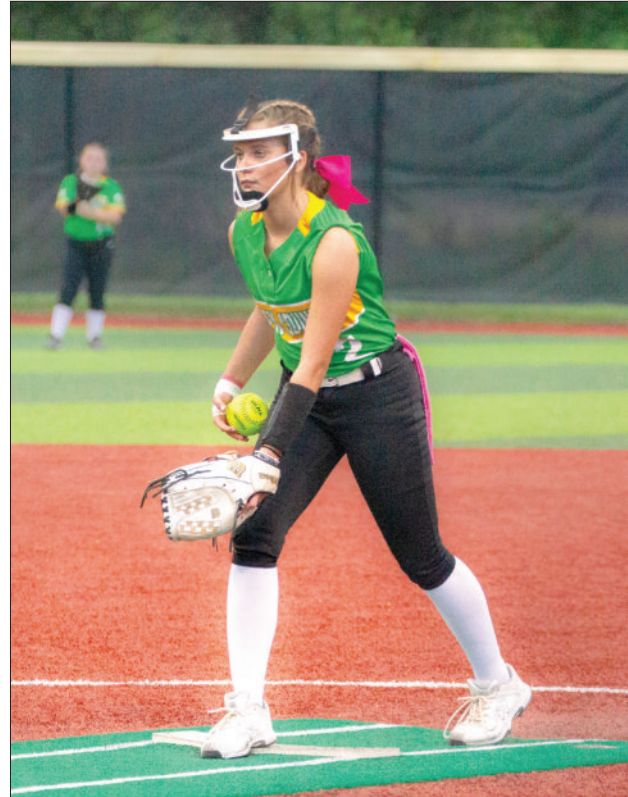


MacKenzie Johnson is one of two seniors on this year's Lady Dragon softball team.

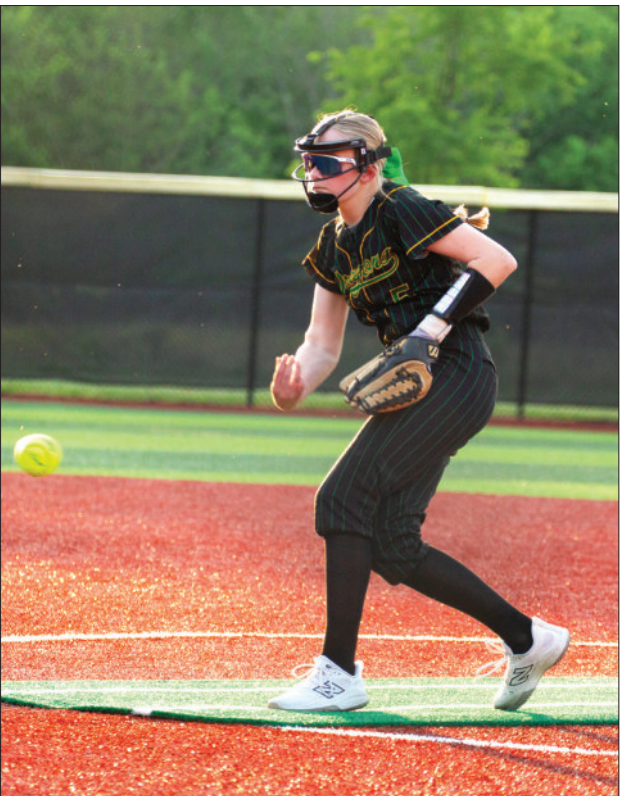
