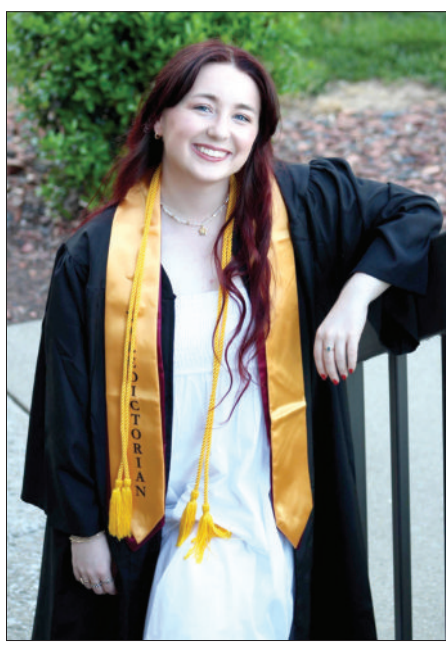


CU Co-valedictorian: Sidney Jones combines accounting, music, and sports management

Green County High School graduate Sidney Jones has continued her academic and extra-curricular excellence at Campbellsville University (CU) and is now recognized for her achievements.

Jones will graduate this weekend with a 4.0 grade point average. She will be honored as a co-valedictorian and will also receive the accounting award. Her degree is a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, Emphasis in Accounting, with minors in Music and Sports Management.

In addition to being a full-time student, Jones has also managed to work one and two part-time jobs during college as well as participate in the Tiger Marching Band at CU, be part of various musical ensembles and often play flute in church on Sundays.
